Directions to Peterborough Locks **Coming from the WEST**

Take Hwy. 115 to Peterborough. Take the Parkway exit, turn right onto Lansdowne St. Proceed to Lock Street which is one set of lights past George St. at the Memorial Centre Arena. Turn right onto Lock St. (south) and then turn left on the first street, Morrow St. (east) OR the second street, Montgomery St. (east) which will both bring you right into Morphet St. Parking is a large paved area at Lock 19. Vehicles can be left overnight at Lock 19.

Coming from the EAST

Take Hwy. 7/Lansdowne St. East to Peterborough. Turn left onto Lock Street (south) at the Memorial Centre Arena and then turn left on the first street, Morrow St. (east) OR the second street Montgomery St. (east) which will both bring you right into Morphet St. Parking is a large paved area at Lock 19. Vehicles can be left overnight at Lock 19.
